Final Transnational Project Meeting in Pamplona (Spain)



On 30th September 2025, the partners of the FOLLOW APP project gathered in Pamplona (Spain) for the fifth and final Transnational Project Meeting. Hosted by AIN (Asociación de la Industria Navarra) and coordinated by INFODEF (Spain), the meeting marked a key milestone in closing the project's operational phase and preparing its final outputs and sustainability actions. The agenda included:

- A detailed **analysis of the international piloting phase and the Guidelines & Recommendations** derived from its results (presented by GOI – Istanbul Directorate of National Education).

- A complete **review of all project deliverables** and Work Packages (WP1-WP5), including the final status of the Virtual Campus, Web App, dissemination efforts, and KPIs.
- An **update on the Exploitation & Sustainability Strategy**, led by AIN, including the presentation of the Sustainability Commitment signed by all partners.
- A forward-looking **discussion on how to expand the use and impact of the project outcomes** after its completion.

The meeting concluded with strong commitment from all partners to maintain and promote the project's tools, particularly the open-access digital resources until 2030.



International Multiplier Conference

Celebrating Impact and Future Pathways



Following the partner meeting, the International Multiplier Conference took place at AIN's headquarters in Pamplona. With the participation of key stakeholders from the region and across Europe, the event aimed to showcase the most important results of FOLLOW APP and to stimulate **dialogue around innovation in graduate tracking for Dual VET systems**.

Key highlights from the agenda included:

- Institutional welcome by regional education authorities and project coordinators.
- Presentation of the project's key results, including the **Virtual Campus, the Web App, the Guidelines and Policy Recommendations, and the Sustainability and Exploitation Strategy**.



- Real testimonies from teachers, learners and company trainers who participated in the pilot.
- A high-level expert panel, featuring stakeholders from Volkswagen Navarra and 3P Biopharmaceuticals, who reflected on the applicability of FOLLOW APP tools in the private sector.
- An **open discussion** with the audience and final networking lunch with all partners and guests.

The conference successfully positioned FOLLOW APP as a **pioneering project in digital graduate tracking**, creating real synergies between VET systems, companies and policy-makers. The project's resources will continue to serve as Open Educational Resources (OER) for years to come.

Attendees appreciated the project's practical tools and recognized that FOLLOW APP offers not only a methodology but also a **scalable model** for improving transparency, data collection, and student support across Europe. The consortium encouraged all participants to explore the web application and virtual campus and consider ways to adopt and integrate them into local educational contexts.

A long-term European resource beyond 2025

Although the creation and development phase of FOLLOW APP concludes in October 2025, the project's journey is far from over. Thanks to a robust Exploitation and Sustainability Strategy led by AIN (Asociación de la Industria Navarra) and supported by all partners, FOLLOW APP will continue to deliver value well beyond its official end date.

The strategy outlines a clear roadmap to ensure that the project results — including the Virtual Campus, the Web Application, and the Policy Guidelines — remain accessible, useful, and impactful for years to come. One of the standout commitments is the guarantee that all digital tools and learning resources will be available as Open Educational Resources (OERs) until at least 2030.

To make this possible, all partners have signed a Sustainability Commitment and contributed to a collective action plan involving:

- Integrating the tools into their own training or guidance systems,
- Promoting the resources through European and national networks,
- Ensuring technical and institutional support for continued use.

The project's results have already shown strong potential for transferability to other educational and professional contexts, and efforts are underway to reach more stakeholders, policy actors, and training institutions across Europe.

This strategic focus ensures that FOLLOW APP is not only a successful Erasmus+ initiative, but also a long-lasting reference in digital graduate tracking for Dual VET.
